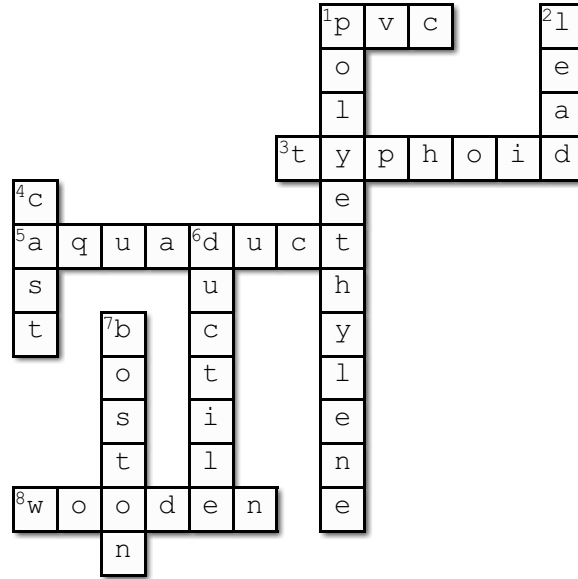


# Water Pipes, Then and Now

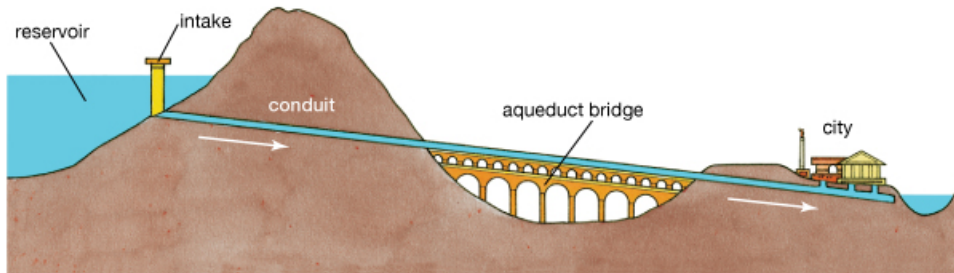
## Across

- Americas first water treatment plant was built here in 1652. (**boston**)
